CSA: What's that about?

"CSA" is an abbreviation for the concept of "Community Supported Agriculture," a program in which share-holders make an upfront payment, and get a weekly supply of fruits and vegetables throughout the growing season. Each week's share will be a surprise, encouraging you to cook creatively with new ingredients. It's the perfect crash course in locavore living! Through a Fishkill Farms CSA share, you'll get the opportunity to eat the freshest, highest-quality local food—grown and harvested with utmost care.

Why choose the Fishkill Farms CSA?

Fishkill Farms is a family-owned, third-generation fruit and vegetable farm in the town of East Fishkill. We grow a diverse array of vegetables and berries (using strict organic methods, but not certified). Unlike many other CSA farms, we also grow a variety of luscious tree fruit. Organic fruit is extremely difficult to produce in the tempestuous climate of the Northeast, so we opt for a low-spray, ecological approach on our apples, peaches, cherries and plums. We only spray them with the gentlest materials when it's absolutely necessary to protect the crop, and are certified Eco-Friendly by Red Tomato. This means that our produce is safer for you, better for the environment, and sustainably-grown in all senses of the word.

The Details...

Our Brooklyn CSA pickup hours are Saturdays from 9am to 12pm. Our pickup site is the Old Stone House in Park Slope—located at 336 3rd St, Brooklyn, NY.

Fruit and Vegetable Shares

Standard Share: \$950, due at time of registration.* A typical share should accommodate the veggie needs of a 4-person family, and contain about 10 items per week, for 25 weeks. **Small Share**: \$550, due at time of registration.* This share should include approximately 6-7 items per week, for 25 weeks.

Additional Shares

Egg Share: \$138, due at time of registration.* This includes 1 dozen eggs per week for 25 weeks.

Milk Shares: Prices vary, please see application. A weekly standing order for local dairy products from Hudson Valley Fresh, able to be picked up alongside your weekly produce.

Meat Shares: Prices vary, please see application for website link. Species-specific shares include frozen cuts of pork (total pickup amount of ~15lbs) whole and half-lambs, and whole chickens. Meat share pickups will occur on a monthly basis, June-November.

*Full payment in advance helps support the farm when it counts the most—in the spring when the season's supplies must be purchased. However, if this represents a financial hardship, please let us know and we will do our best to arrange a payment plan that works for you and the farm.
